To Whom It May Concern:

Porta Serve provides portable sanitation services using industry standard practices that define our Standard Operating Procedures. Service is provided to toilets on a regular basis, at least one time per week, and for most of our agricultural clients two to three times per week when needed. Service includes replacing toilet paper, paper towels, hand soap, hand washing water and the pumping of the toilet. Dates of service are recorded, and records of service are kept with the driver's daily logs.

- Units are located near working locations but not in close proximity to crops,
- Crews remove trash left inside the unit at the start of each cleaning,
- Waste material is removed from the toilet tank,
- Graffiti is removed and the condition of the units is checked,
- Blue deodorizer and anti-bacterial agent are placed in the tank along with 5 to 8 gallons of clean water,
- Inside of units are sprayed using Eco-Lab 2, a *hospital grade sterilizing agent*. Wipe down occurs on the toilet seat (the sterilizing agent is most effective when allowed to evaporate from surfaces).
- The supply of hand soap and paper towels is replenished for units with sinks.
- Grey water is removed from sinks and the freshwater tank is replenished.

During service, if any spill or leakage is noted the site contact will be notified along with any field supervisor near the toilet. Any spills will be removed per DEP guidelines consistent with our state issued permit.

Water from the trucks is supplied by municipal sources or certified wells. The hand washing units contain this water and are for hand washing only. Drinking the water is not permitted and multi-language stickers indicate this on each sink.

All trucks are equipped with a hospital grade disinfecting system using EcoLab 2 cleaner.

Our units meet State of Florida Health Department code 64-E6 requirements. Our Florida Department of Health permit is: 01-QA-1563205. Per our permit, waste is stored in onsite FRAC tanks before being collected and transported to a treatment facility by Raymond's Septic Service in O'Brien, FL.
